## What is an SAR? How do I get one?

## The SAR is required for the Scholarships Inc, application – the FAFSA will *not* be accepted! If a SAR is not submitted, the application will not be processed.

Once a FAFSA application or correction is processed, you will receive a Student Aid Report (SAR) in one of the following ways:

- If you provided a valid *e-mail address*, an e-mail notification will be sent to you, within 3 to 5 days, with instructions on how to access an online copy of the SAR to print.
- If no valid e-mail address is on file, the SAR will be mailed to you by postal mail within 7 to 10 days.

## To print your SAR:

- 1. Log in to your student FAFSA account on fafsa.edu.gov
- 2. When you are logged on to your **My FAFSA** account, go to the bottom of the page and click the link to **View or Print Processed Information**
- 3. This should bring up your Student Aid Report it will say Electronic Student Aid Report (SAR) in the top right corner

**Note:** You cannot access your SAR until your PIN information has been verified by the Social Security Administration (1-3 days after you submit your PIN application). If you have recently applied for your PIN, you may have to wait 1-3 days before using it to view your SAR.
